*Statement by Suiker Unie concerning the application of genetically modified organisms**


For the production of sugar, sugar specialties, molasses and beet pulp, Suiker Unie only uses raw materials obtained from traditionally propagated plant species.

All relevant precautions have been taken to prevent contamination with genetically modified organisms and/or their derivatives.

During the production of sugar, sugar specialties, molasses and beet pulp, no use is made of processing aids produced by means of genetic modification.

Consequently, in compliance with Regulation (EC) no 1829/2003 and Regulation (EC) 1830/2003, no GMO labelling and traceability requirements are applicable for the products of Suiker Unie.
